The Commission has received several inquiries regarding students who graduate from charter schools and their eligibility for State Scholarships at USC-Beaufort.

According to scholarship regulation a student must graduate from a SC high school or home school program. Students who graduate from a charter high school are graduating from a public high school in South Carolina. Therefore, these students are eligible to receive State Scholarships if the eligibility criteria are met.
