USC offers engineering scholarship to freshmen: USC engineering and computing freshmen who are South Carolina residents will be eligible for a new scholarship to cover the difference between tuition and the state-funded LIFE scholarship. The new Engineering and Computing Expanded Life Scholarship will mean free tuition for at least 100 freshmen who also have LIFE scholarships and are majors in the College of Engineering and Computing. USC officials expect the new scholarships to be about \$5,400 per student.
