USC – COLUMBIA’S BRIDGE PROGRAM: This program is designed to make transitions from S.C. technical colleges to USC-Columbia as seamless as possible and to increase the success of transfer students once they are enrolled at the Columbia campus. While the Bridge Program will enhance eligible students’ transitions to USC-Columbia, the program does not offer special admissions considerations to students. Students who apply to USC-C as incoming freshmen and are eligible for the Bridge Program will receive information from Undergraduate Admissions. Students who do not apply to USC-C as incoming freshmen, but are interested at a later time, should meet with a University admissions counselor or with the Bridge Program representatives at their technical colleges to determine eligibility. Students seeking to transfer from S.C. technical colleges are not required to be in the Bridge Program.
